



2016-17 Boy Scout Programs:

BOY SCOUT MERIT FOR PHOTOGRAPHY

Date: Saturday, November 5, 2016

Time: 1:00-4:00 pm

Description: Scouts will learn about camera techniques, the difference between film and digital photographs and cameras, photograph manipulation computer programs and career opportunities in photography. Afterwards scouts will be able to visit the sculpture museum galleries and garden to create their own photographic story. Scouts should bring their own cameras.

Minimum and maximum for class (scout count only): 8 minimum and 15 maximum.

Fee: \$7 per scout and \$3 per adult **Deadline for registering: October 28, 2016**

Supplies: Scout should bring their own digital camera (cell, point and shoot or SLR).

BOY SCOUT MERIT FOR ART

Date: Saturday, February 25, 2017

Time: 1:00-4:00 pm

Description: Museum staff will discuss art, its importance to culture and us. Scouts will take a guided tour of the museum which includes discussion of the artist/sculptor Marshall Fredericks and his art career, casting process, visit to the Studio, main gallery and temporary exhibition galleries. The visual elements and principles of design will be discussed.

Art activities: Scouts will create an image in four different media from this list: watercolor, color pencil, tempera, pastels, and ink. They will also design their own logo with their name in any of these media.

Minimum and maximum for class (scout count only): 8 minimum and 15 maximum.

Fee: \$9 per scout and \$3 per adult **Deadline for registering: February 17, 2017**

Supplies: All supplies are provided by the museum. Scouts should wear art making clothes.

BOY SCOUT MERIT FOR SCULPTURE

Date: Saturday, March 18, 2017

Time: 1:00-4:00 pm

Description: Scouts will tour the main gallery, sculptor's studio, learn about the metal casting process and visit the temporary exhibition. The tour guide will discuss the importance of visual arts and about Marshall Fredericks' profession as a Public Sculptor and other sculpting professions. For their art activity scouts will make a plaster relief sculpture. In order to obtain the proper supplies the museum requests 4 weeks or more lead time.

Minimum and Maximum for class (scout count only): 8 minimum and 13 maximum.

Fee: \$10 per scout and \$3 per adult **Deadline for registering: February 18, 2017**

Supplies: The museum will supply materials. Scouts should bring these items: face mask, apron, eye protection, shoe box or similar box to carry items and poly gloves. Scouts should wear art making clothes.
