Kitchen Lithography

Participants will learn the traditional process of lithography printmaking using common kitchen items. This printing method relates to the offset printing process of conditioning a surface to repel ink using acid (in this case soda pop) and accept ink using grease crayons. Andrea is an artist, adjunct faculty at SVSU, and Curator of Education at the Marshall M. Fredericks Sculpture Museum.
