Time: 1:00-4:00 pm

Description: Scouts will learn about photograph ethics, camera properties, photo manipulating computer programs and how to make a PowerPoint slideshow. Afterwards they will take photos from different vantage points, perspectives and motion. Scouts can then create slide shows of their photos.

Minimum and Maximum for class: 10 minimum and 20 maximum.

Fee: \$6 per scout and \$3 per adult
